Constitutional Crisis?



There is much talk from Democrats and the mainstream media about a "Constitutional Crisis" created by President Trump's efforts working with Elon Musk and DOGE to dramatically cut federal spending by eliminating the massive waste fraud and abuse of your tax dollars. The President is acting fully within his authority under Article II, Section 1 of the US Constitution, "The

executive Power shall be vested in a President of the United States of America."
